

The Symbiont Boot Stick - SBS1500

QUICK START

Thank you for purchasing the Symbiont Boot Stick (SBS). The SBS is a USB device that enables anyone to boot up a PC, laptop, traditional or stateless thin client and connect to a terminal server, run a local web browser or present an Adobe Flash® presentation via a standard USB1.1 or USB2.0 interface. The SBS completely eliminates the complex setup and support associated with installation, setup, and software management on PCs, laptops, and thin clients. Once configured, the SBS will boot up the same way every time.

The device on which the SBS will be used (called an "SBS HOST") must be configured to boot up from a USB hard drive. Refer to the manufacturer's manual for more details on configuring the SBS HOST. If booting your SBS HOST from a USB hard drive is not an option, you can visit <http://www.symbio-technologies.com> and download the SBS Companion CD boot image (iso). You can burn the CD image onto a CD, set your SBS HOST BIOS to boot from a CD, then boot directly from the CD/DVD ROM drive.



1. Insert the SBS into any USB port on the SBS HOST and press power button.

Note: If you are using the SBS Companion CD, it should be in the CD/DVD ROM drive at this time.

2. When prompted, select "Configuration Wizard" and then press "Enter".

3. Choose a session from the drop down menu and fill in the details.

Tip: When finished, you can click the "Advanced" button in the lower left corner for more options.

4. When prompted to enter a password to password-protect the configuration, enter a password or leave the space blank to have no password.

5. The SBS HOST will now reboot and automatically load your settings.
